(Summary of entire period)

## Seventy Weeks were Decreed

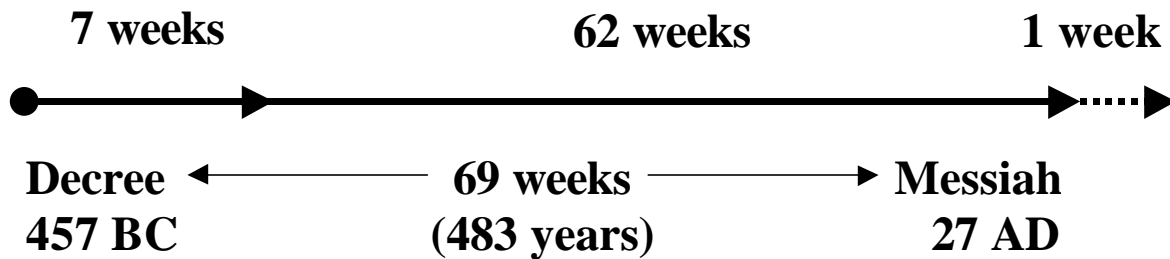
Begin ←———— 70 weeks —————→ End  
(490 years)



Seventy weeks (490 years) remained on God's prophetic clock for the Jews, their temple, and their city. That time was decreed so that:

- A. Their transgression would be finished
- B. Their sin would be ended
- C. Atonement would be made for iniquity
- D. Everlasting righteousness would be brought in
- E. Vision and prophecy (for them) would be sealed up
- F. The Most Holy would be anointed

## Verse 25

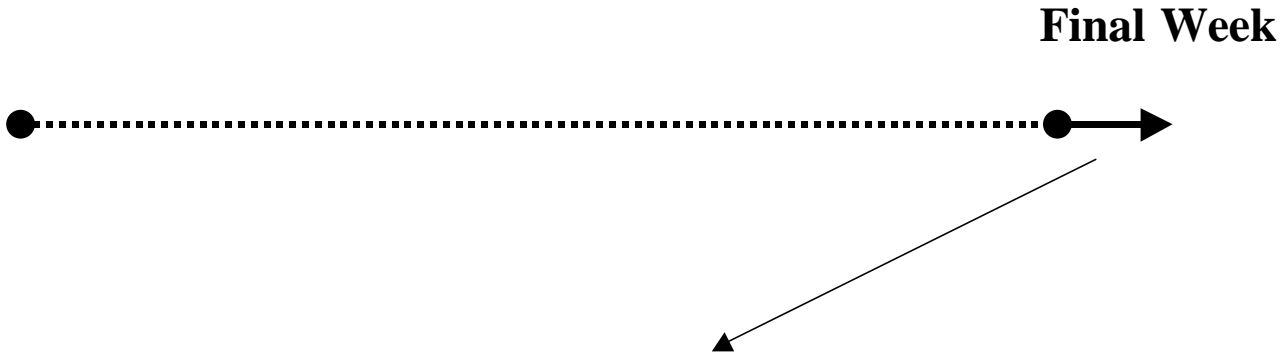


1. From the decree until Messiah would be 7 + 62 weeks (or 69 total weeks.)
2. At some time during this period (presumably during the first 7 weeks) the temple would be rebuilt in times of distress.

## Verse 26

1. Sometime after the 62 week portion (this verse does not specify how long after):
  - Messiah would be *“cut off and have nothing”*
  - The *“people of the prince [who was] to come”* would destroy the city and the temple once again
  - The destruction would come during a time of war.
